

2020 CAOG Annual Meeting Napa, California Postponed

Not surprisingly, given these crazy, uncertain, and unprecedented times in a world affected by the coronavirus pandemic, the Executive Board and Program Committee has decided to postpone the 87th Annual Meeting of Central Association of Obstetricians and Gynecologists until October 2021.

The location has been postponed for one year but there will be an abbreviated morning with two presentations and the Annual Business Meeting via Zoom.

The Meritage Resort in Napa, California has finally agreed to allow for the one-year postponement without a financial penalty and basically under the terms of the original contract (although room rates will be \$30 per night higher).

The new dates will be earlier in October, specifically October 6-9, 2021 (Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday) with the Welcome Reception on Wednesday and the Scientific Program the next three days.

The Board has agreed to have a 3-hour Zoom meeting starting at 9 a.m. Central time on Saturday, October 31, 2020 (the last day of the original meeting and still on Halloween). This meeting would include two scientific presentations followed by the mandatory CAOG Annual Business Meeting with a noon adjournment. CME availability is still being decided.
